

Governor's Cup

What is it?

The Governor's Cup is a district championship 300 round shot on the NFAA blue & white target face.

Participation

The Governor's Cup is open to OAA/NAA members and guests. Guests will not be eligible for the Governor's Cup title, but high guest scores will be awarded. Archers may shoot in any district, but scores will be applied to their district of residency. Archers may only submit one score for the Governor's Cup. If participating in more than 1 Governor's Cup tournament, only the first score will be counted. Any archer who begins a tournament but does not submit a score will receive an official score of zero (0) points for the Governor's Cup unless a score has previously been submitted from another district shoot.

Awards

The Governor's Cup will be awarded to the highest score in each class in each district. Classifications (AA, A, & B) will not be in effect for the Governor's Cup. High guest scores will be recognized by certificate, or similar award. All awards will be presented at the OAA Indoor 300 Championships.

Scoring and Rules

Rules and scoring will follow the standard procedure for the NFAA 300 round. See the 300 Round section of the Tournament Rules page at www.ohioarchery.com for more information.

Ties

Any scoring ties will be broken by X count. If a tie still exists, the tie will then be broken by the first X dropped. If a tie still exists beyond this, the tied shooters will compete in a head to head shoot-off at the OAA Indoor 300. Any shooter scheduled to appear in a shoot-off who does not show up will forfeit the win.

300 Classifier

Governor's Cup scores will count as classifier scores for the OAA Indoor 300 Championships. Archers may choose to use this score to register to shoot against their peers (AA, A, and B classifications) at the OAA Indoor 300. Archers are permitted to register for a higher classification if so desired.

Additional Information

Because this is a district level event, no Shooter of the Year points will be awarded and this event does not count toward the Iron Archer award. Similar to the mail-in events, there will be no Money Class offered at the Governor's Cup.
