Affiliation

Any Ohio based, public or private club, association, enterprise, or institution may affiliate with the O.A.A., subject to the approval of the Board of Governors. Such affiliated organizations then become subordinated arms of the O.A.A. who are encouraged to:

- a. Represent their membership to the O.A.A.
- b. Serve as the business link between their membership and the O.A.A.
- c. Serve as a host organization for the O.A.A. State Tournaments.
- d. Above all always act in the best interest of the O.A.A.

Affiliation Fees :

An organization may affiliate with the O.A.A. for a fee of \$30.00, or **free** with one of the following conditions.

- Hosting of any OAA event (excluding the 300 classifier) and post the OAA poster with the schedule on it.
- Or have 5 OAA memberships and post the OAA poster.

Note: This completed form should be filed by Dec. 1 of each year.

Your O.A.A. affiliation dues entitle your shop / club to a listing on our web page. Your shop / club will also receive a copy of each newsletter. These dues also allow your shop / club to participate in all O.A.A. activities.
